



- 2. The indicator lights up, indicating that it starts charging.


Cutter Cleaning and Maintenance

Clear up the blade with cleaning brush.


Note





- 1. Please do not disassemble the product.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with this appliance. When using electric appliance, especially when children are present, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following.

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING

WARNING: KEEP APPLIANCE DRY. KEEP AWAY FROM WATER WHEN IT IS CHARGING DANGER: As with most electrical appliances, electric parts are electrically live when switch is OFF.

To reduce the risk of death by electric shock:

- 1. Do not use while bathing or in shower.
- 2. Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- 3. Do not place it in or drop it into water or any other liquid.
- 4. If an appliance falls into water, unplugit immediately. Do not reach into the water.
- 5. Always unplug this appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using. Unplug this appliance before cleaning.

 and repair.
- 8. Never allow the power supply cord to be pulled, jerked, strained, twisted, or severely bent, especially at the plug connections. Damage will occur at the high flex point of entry into the appliance, causing it to rupture and short circuit. Handle the cord carefully for longer life of cord.
- 9. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces. Do not wrap the cord around the appliance.
- 10. Never drop or insert any object(s) into any opening.
- 11. Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol spray products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- 12.Do not use an extension cord with this appliance.
- 13. Never use while sleeping.
- 14. Do not operate with voltage converter.
- 15. Do not use this appliance with a damaged or broken comb, as facial injury may occur. To disconnect, turn the switch to "off" then remove plug from outlet.
